ZOOM BALINT GROUP FOR PUBLIC PSYCHIATRISTS

What is a Balint Group?

A Balint group work is a space for clinical reflection with a focus on the doctorpatient relationship and its emotional aspects. Balint groups supports a range of clinicians, particularly with the emotional aspects of their work.

During a group meeting, a patient or situation which has stayed in the clinician's mind is presented informally. No preparation is necessary; the clinician is invited to speak spontaneously about whatever comes to mind about the case. The group might ask a few factual questions.

Then the presenter rests, listening while the group explores the experiences of those involved. We try to develop a deep understanding of the experiences of the patient and the clinician in particular.

The focus is on exploration of the *emotional* experiences of those involved rather than problem-solving, diagnosis or management.

Who should join this group?

Psychiatrists working in the public system face unique challenges. This group offers a forum to explore that experience, developing a deeper understanding of the complex experiences of doctor and patient.

The group is open to all psychiatrists who are working in the public health system, as well as those who have worked publicly in the past.

Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

This group is registered with the RANZCP for CPD and attendance will be entered after each meeting. A separate attendance letter can also be provided on request.
